  - a. Full LCAP document Draft 2024
    - i. All of those goals have remained the same from the 2023-2024 school year.
  - b. Review
    - i. Budget Overview for Parents
    - ii. Goal 1 changes page 12 and page 14
      - 1. Focus on English Learners, literacy & mathematics.
        - a. Intensive PD in math for grades 6-8.
        - TK-3 grade professional development to help support the science of reading, phonemes, phonics, decoding, fluency and comprehension.
        - c. 5th-8th grade teachers will continue PD in writing.
        - d. PD for classified staff will be added.
      - 2. RLA will now be extended to 4th grade
    - iii. Goal 2 changes pages 24 and 25
      - 1. We have to ensure our budget aligns correctly with our actions.
      - 2. We have hired an early literacy coach to help all 5 elementary schools.
      - 3. We will continue to have k-8 counselors at each elementary site, but they will no longer be paid out of this goal.

- iv. Goal 4 change page 31
  - 1. Harvest qualified for Equity Multiplier since their suspension rate was a little higher, we have implemented a counselor to help improve instability, attendance, and suspension rates.
  - 2. Next year, if dashboard results show improvement, this goal will be removed.

- f. TK update
  - i. We have 4 classes currently: Ripona, Park View, Weston, and Ripon Elementary.
  - ii. If needed, we will reopen another class at Ripona
- 3. Summer School Update
  - a. Intervention summer school starts May 31st and goes through June 28th
  - b. We have around 200 kids attending in grades ranging TK-5
  - c. We will also have a couple of music classes in the afternoon
  - d. This year we added a STEM class
- 4. Safety
  - a. All schools have completed their safety drills for this year
  - b. We are still planning to work to a bigger safety practice next year
- 5. Professional Development for teacher next year (bilingual para initial ELPAC certification 8/5/24)
  - a. All ELPAC testing has been completed
  - b. We will begin training for next year's Initial ELPAC soon
- 6. First day of school August 7, 2024
- 7. Celebration: Seal of Biliteracy/Pathway to Biliteracy 5/13/24 a. This board meeting we will recognize our recipients
- 8. Board approved ALTA language assessment for Seal Award
  - a. We have many kids who speak languages other than Spanish
  - b. We can now use this assessment for our 8th graders to receive their Pathway or Seal.

- 10. Bilingual Dinner school year 2024-2025 (Parent input)
  - a. We are considering a new date this year to avoid the rain
  - b. We are also considering hosting a resource night for parents instead of having a speaker this year

  - 3. Mrs. Landa at the last DELAC meeting we were talking about a class for parents on vaping.
    - a. Mrs. Diederich- we have taken note of that and are still figuring that out on the highschool level since there are more families with younger students who attend EL family night.
- ii. We are also considering having more entertainment during dinner and then breaking out into classes
- 11. High School EL goal and UDL with an EL focus
  - a. Ripon High School had to write a goal on how to address how to meet the ELPAC goals
  - b. The county will be helping them incorporate strategies to help address those goals
- 12. Dual Language program County support to streamline program
  - a. The county is helping support our teachers to ensure our program is working well and how to implement it through 5th grade
- 13. Input
  - a. Parent- Will the Seal be for the seniors?
    - i. Yes, it is from the county, and the seal goes on their diploma from the State of California
