### New business included:

- Congratulations to the Perry Panthers Football team on making history. The Panthers will compete for the state championship December 12, at 4:00 in the Mercedes Benz stadium.
- PHS Drama Department
  - Competed at the Georgia Theater Conference and placed first in the state. They will travel to Alabama in March to compete at the Southeastern Theater Conference.
  - Won Region for One Act Play, *Failure: A Love Story*. They placed second at the state competition
  - Will perform Winnie the Pooh to over 2,000 elementary students December 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. The public performance will be December 8 at 7:00 and December 9 at 2:00. Admission is \$5.00

- Alcohol and Drug Awareness (APAD) test was administered to Freshmen on Wednesday, November 29.

- Flu shots – Given to faculty and students who signed up, November 8<sup>th</sup>
