- 5. We will provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress. Specifically, the school will provide a progress report at 4 ½ weeks and every nine weeks. These reports will be sent to parents in the Wednesday Courier and can be accessed through the parent portal.
- 6. We will be available for consultations with parents during planning periods, after school, and during Parent-Teacher Conferences in which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual student's achievement.

Parent's Responsibility

- 1. I will log in to the Parent Portal in Infinite Campus at least once a week to monitor my child's attendance, assignments, and grades to ensure progress and expectations are being met. I will also communicate with my child's teachers regularly via email, phone, Class Dojo, or Google Classroom.
- 2. I will ensure that my child utilizes the resources given by the school, either at home or the public library.
- 3. I will ensure that my child spends at least 30 minutes each day independently practicing core content taught in class or small group instruction.
