- Mrs. Burrows welcomed all those who were in attendance
- She then went over the school's areas of improvements: Culture & student leadership, instruction, and test scores
- Mrs. Burrows explained that the culture goal was being met using the following:
 Capturing Kids Hearts components, advisor/advisee program, after school tutoring for 1st grade, safety patrol hall monitors, and student led announcements
- She explained that the instructional goals were being met through the use of stations in classrooms, increased instructional time, interventionists which focuses on the individual needs of each student
- Mrs. Burrows let everyone know that she would email a copy of the PowerPoint to them to look over later
- She then reviewed how the improving test scores goal was being met: school leadership team, meeting student needs, MTSS, learning walks, PLC – backwards by design, after school tutoring
- Mrs. Bellflowers mentions how backwards by design has impacted and improved their instruction in 5K classrooms
- Mrs. Burrows asked if anyone wanted to add anything
- Mrs. Bellflowers mentions student growth should be included under the instructional goal
