Q: When is the Troy School District running their annual Supplemental Levy Election?

A: The Troy School District Supplemental Levy Election will be run on May 17th at the Troy Lion's Hall.

Q: How much will the Supplemental Levy be?

A: The Supplemental Levy was set at \$995,000

Q: Is this a replacement Levy from last year?

A: Yes, this Supplemental Levy replaces the Levy that was passed in August 2015 and expires June 2016. We must run a Supplemental Levy every year in order to continue the current programs.

Q: Will our taxes go up?

A: No, because we paid off the bond for the Troy Elementary School, your taxes should go down slightly.

Q: What programs does the Supplemental Levy support?

A: The Supplemental Levy supports approximately one-third of our general fund. Therefore, we are able to support one-third of everything we offer due to the Supplemental Levy. The Troy School District currently has the following programs:
