The elementary school playground was recently damaged by a tree during a storm.

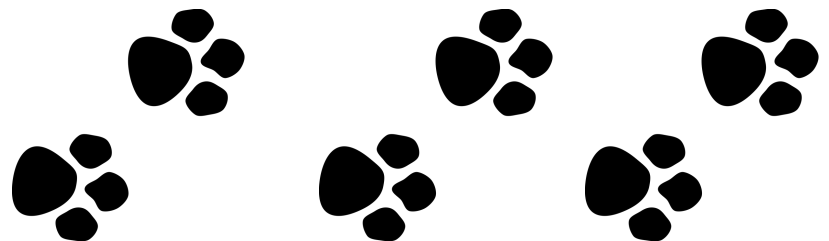
