The South Carroll County Special School District Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, September 20, 2018, at Clarksburg School, Clarksburg, Tennessee.

#### I. Call to Order

Chairman Bartholomew called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

#### II. Reorganization of Board of Education – Election of Officers

Mr. Gurley made a motion to leave the officers as they are. Mr. Moore seconded the motion and it passed.

#### III. Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting

Mr. Moore made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting of August 16, 2018. Mrs. Blount seconded the motion and it passed.

#### IV. Approval of Agenda

Chairman Bartholomew requested that discussion on Softball and Baseball Fields and discussion on SRO Officer be added to New Business. Mr. Gurley made a motion to approve the Agenda with these items added. Mr. Moore seconded the motion and it was approved.

#### V. Consent Agenda

C. Accept Resignation of Deborah Barger

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Mrs. Blount seconded the motion and it was approved.

VI. New Business

A. Discuss/Approve Changes to Board Policy 4.700 Testing Programs

Student scores on Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program in grades three through eight (3-8) has changed to include grades three through eleven (3-11). Mrs. Blount made a motion to approve the change to this policy. Mr. Moore seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Mr. Moore—yes; Mr. Gurley—yes; Mr. Miller—yes; Mrs. Blount—yes; Mr. Bartholomew—yes. Motion passed 1<sup>st</sup> Reading.

B. Discuss SRO Officer

Dr. Tucker informed the Board that this is a contracted service with the Carroll County Sheriff's Department. Approximate cost will be forty-nine to fifty thousand (\$49,000-\$50,000) per year. Mr. Gurley made a motion to hire a SRO Officer and allow Dr. Tucker to hire at his discretion. Mr. Moore seconded the motion with the option of a two-year contract with the Sheriff's Department. After some discussion concerning the two year contract, the motion was approved.

C. Discuss Baseball and Softball Fields

There was some discussion on who was responsible for caring for the field. Coaches usually take this responsibility. Dr. Tucker informed the Board that the mowing contract is set up for mowing in two week intervals. It was recommended that they might set up a meeting with coaches to discuss problems. Mr. Moore recommended that FFA could work on fields if any of their teaching standards would align.

VII. Old Business

A. Discuss/Approve 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading on Board Policy 3.404 Private Vehicles

B. Discuss/Approve 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading on Board Policy 6.200 Attendance

Mr. Moore made a motion to combine the two policies and approve them on second reading. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Mr. Moore—yes; Mr. Gurley—yes; Mr. Miller—yes; Mrs. Blount—yes; Mr. Bartholomew—yes. Motion passed second reading.

VIII. Adjournment

Mr. Gurley made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Moore seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm.
