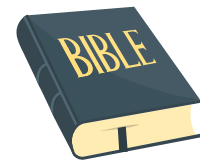
In the Gospel today, Jesus says to us: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you."

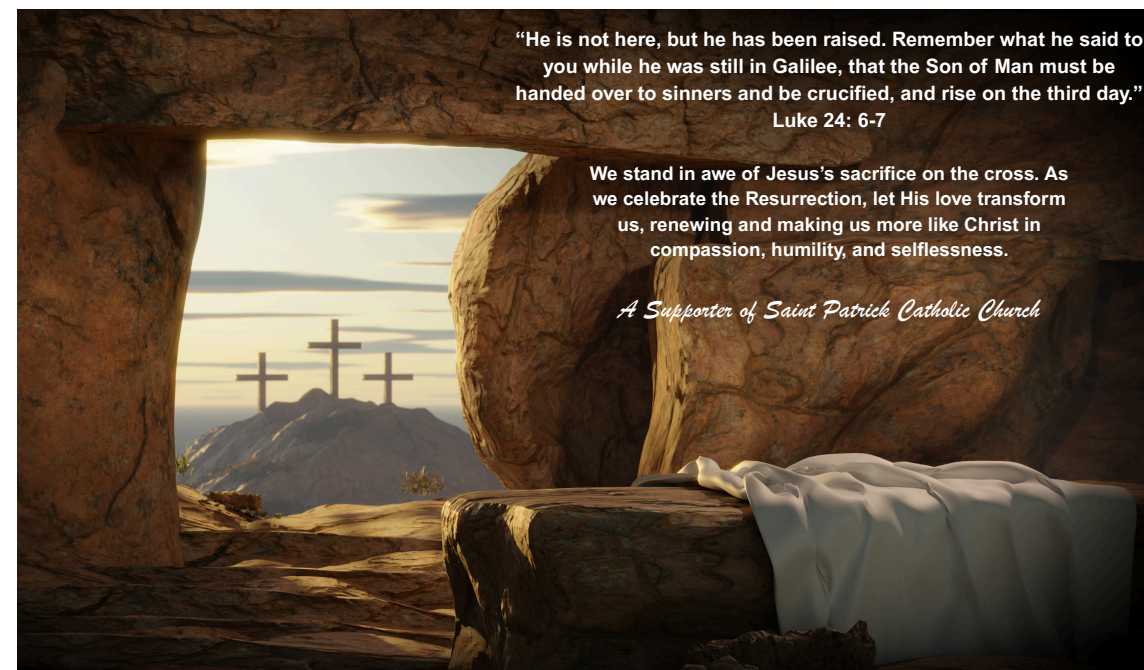
