

# Honors Courses Addendum

Honor Graduate criteria (starting with the Class of 2027):

**Honors:** Seniors must have passed 10 honors courses and have a GPA of 3.5 on all courses taken in grades 9-12.

**High Honors:** Seniors must have passed 10 honors courses including one AP course and have a GPA of 3.75 on all courses taken in grades 9-12.

**Highest Honors:** Seniors must have passed 10 honors courses including two AP courses in at least two subject areas (art, history, language, math, and/or science) and have a GPA of 4.0 on all courses taken in grades 9-12.

The Valedictorian will be the senior with the best overall GPA. The Salutatorian will be the senior with the second-best overall GPA. Both the Valedictorian and Salutatorian must complete the Smart Core Curriculum, be an Honor Graduate and attend Pottsville High School three out of the four years during grades 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>. Students that wish to be an Honor Graduate must take ten of the following courses:

The Valedictorian will be the senior with the best overall GPA. The Salutatorian will be the senior with the second-best overall GPA. Both the Valedictorian and Salutatorian must complete the Smart Core Curriculum, be an Honor Graduate and attend Pottsville High School three out of the four years during grades 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>. Students that wish to be an Honor Graduate must take nine of the following courses:
