In speaking earlier with Megan, she requested our largest need. Currently we have most need for technology in the classroom and replacements.

- 1- A current quote for 36 Chromebooks is attached for **\$10,318.93**. Ideally, 4th grade only has one cart of 35 Chromebooks but approximately 10 are needing major service repairs. I would like to supply them with at least 15 Chromebooks and the rest to be given to 3rd grade to share and in the upcoming years the goal is to supply each 3rd grade class with their own carts and 4th grade with their own carts.
- 2- The site has replaced 4 projectors and 4 ELMOs but we have need to replace at the moment 1 more projector that we were unable to replace due to budget constraints. That single quote is **\$645.24**

Please also keep in mind, 5th grade has two carts but the county will stop supporting their use sometime in this next upcoming school year, because the technology is too old. This means they will be unable to access internet capabilities, Study Sink, online google classroom/docs etc. The hope is that district can at least replace one cart next year.
