**Midland High Varsity Volleyball** defeated Saginaw Heritage 3-2 at home in a 5-set thriller on Tuesday night September 17th. The Chemics won set 1, 25-20, lost set 2, 15-25, lost a close set 3, 24-26, then fought back with tenacity and determination as a team to win set 4, 25-14 and clinch the match in a decisive game 5 win, 15-6.

Payton Palmer led the offense with 35 assists, 16 digs, 2 blocks, and 2 kills. Nicole Giardina delivered 21 kills, 9 digs, 4 aces while teammate Avery Stewart contributed 12 kills, 2 blocks. Emmalea TerBurgh had 8 kills, 2 blocks; Lila Rekeweg added 6 kills, 2 blocks, and Brooke Russell had 4 kills, 6 digs, 2 blocks.

On defense, Brigid O'Malley had 23 digs and 6 assists while Bella Kroll added 8 digs, Rhyannah Nunamaker chipped in 6 digs. Peyton Shepardson had 4 digs and a final ace to finish game 5 for the win.

The Chemics Varsity Volleyball continues SVL play at home this Thursday vs. Saginaw United. The varsity record is 8-4 and 2-1 in SVL. Many thanks to a great loud cheering white out crowd!
