Have you heard your student say, "I got a Starbuck today!"?

Star bucks can be turned in for Dojo points or for incentives provided by the teacher or donations.

Each Class also has a "STAR STUDENT." Star students model PAX behavior throughout the day. Each week a new star student is chosen.

Classes are ranked on a 1-5 scale during specials, the class with the highest end of week score gets STAR CLASS of the week. The class as a whole receives something each day like decorated lunch table with music, otter pops, free dress day and extra recess.

### SAP

#### What is the Student Assistance Program?

SAP is a program dedicated to peer to peer support groups, giving students the opportunity to build positive relationships and teaches students to empower each other. The program encourages youth to overcome barriers in their daily lives, such as self-confidence issues, anger management, divorce or separation, bullying, death of a parent or guardian and social interactions.

Group is led by two trained facilitators that are educated in adverse childhood experiences and understand the power of resiliency. SAP consists of three 8-week sessions per school. Group is held once a week, after school for approximately minutes at your child's school.
