### Mid Year Frequently Asked Questions:

# Q: I have concerns for my students academics. Who do I contact?

A: The first line of contact for a student's academic concern are the core teachers. If you believe there is a deeper level of concern or an ongoing concern, you can also reach out the school counselor or assistant principal for your student. A Child Study Team meeting may be requested to bring parents and teachers together to determine the best way to support your student.

# Q: We have an upcoming trip, how do I notify the school?

A: If you have a preplanned trip for your student, please complete an educational trip form prior to the absences for approval. You can download a form from the district website or e-mail: samsattendance@ship.k12.pa.us.

#### Q: I have concerns for my student's mental health and have noticed changes in their behavior. What resources are available for my student.

A. If you notice concerns with your student you may reach out to a school counselor or administrator for guidance. Our building has a Student Assistance Program where students can be referred for a general mental health/drug and alcohol screening to determine additional needs. Additionally, we have a partnership with Aliff counseling that we can refer students to complete counseling on site at the middle school for students.

# Q: It is starting to get cold, where will my student store their winter coat?

A: All students have been assigned a locker and lock. All winter coats should be placed in lockers and not carried from room to room throughout the day. Backpacks should also be in lockers during the school day.

# Q: With Winter approaching, what is the expectation for students on a Flexible Instruction Day?

A: When a Flexible Instruction Day is called by the district students will follow the schedule posted on page 3. Students will log into their classes via the link provided by the teacher in the Google Classroom or Schoology. Students will receive a brief instruction from the teacher than have time to complete the assignment provided.

# **Q:** When will my 8th grade student start planning for the high school?

A: Representatives from the high school will meet with students in 8th grade in mid February regarding scheduling courses for the high school.

A: Each grade level will participate in a field trip or experience toward the end of the year. 6th grade will travel to a Senator's game in Harrisburg, 7th grade will travel to Burd Run for a water study, and 8th grade will take a walking tour and participate in Civil War day.
