What is a Title I School?

Title I was passed in 1965 under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). It is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.

Title I schools receive extra funding (Title I dollars) from the federal government. These dollars are used to:

- Identify students experiencing academic difficulties and provide assistance to help these students.
- Hire additional staff and/or purchase programs, materials, and/or supplies; and
- Conduct parent and family engagement meetings, trainings, events, and/or activities.

What Can Title I Funds Be Used For?

In general, Title I funds may be used for:

- Additional teachers and paraprofessionals,
- Additional training for school staff,
- Extra time for instruction (before, and/or after school programs).
- Parent and family engagement activities, and/or
- A variety of supplemental teaching materials, equipment, and technology.

The NLES LEADERSHIP TEAM determines how to spend these funds in accordance with our School Improvement Plan (SIP). The North Lake SIP includes our school-wide goals and strategic plan for reaching those goals for the upcoming school year. North Lake's goals are essentially to make academic progress in both areas of ELA and Math.

Did you know?

What Are My Rights?

The families and parents of Title I students have a right, by law, to:

- Be involved in decisions made at both the school and district level,
- Be provided with information on your child's level of achievement on tests in reading/language arts, writing, mathematics and science.
- Request and receive information on the qualifications of your child's teacher and paraprofessionals who are working with your child; and

- Request opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions about the education of your child. *The school is required to respond to any such suggestions as soon as practically possible.*

What are our NLES school-wide program goals?

- Academic growth in both ELA and Math
- Increase family and community involvement.

Morning Drop-Offs/Dismissal/ Attendance

Morning Drop-offs

The Morning Drop Off Procedure will stay the same as last year.

ALL students arriving at school before 7:30am will come to the cafeteria (under the awning). They will then go to either the gym or the cafeteria (depending on their grade-level). *Cafeteria (3rd, 4th and 5th graders) and gym (K, 1st, & 2nd graders)*

At 7:30 am, the Kindergarten through 2nd graders will come in at the K-3 awning and the 3rd-5th graders will come in at the cafeteria awning. Bri Smith and Rhonda Stubblefield will be stationed at the K-2 end. Officer Bobby Long will be monitoring the entire building.

Afternoon Pick-Ups

The Afternoon Pick-Up procedure will stay the same. -Pre-K will be dismissed in the cafeteria at 2:30. Parents will sign-out their children before they leave the building. Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd grades and any siblings will be dismissed from the K-2 end. **ALL CLASSROOM TEACHER (K-2) WILL BE OUTSIDE HELPING LOAD THE STUDENTS.**

School Nutrition

NLES Cafeteria: 931-455-9112

Students will be taking part in the “Breakfast In The Classroom Program” which means everyone will be served breakfast from 7:45-8:00 am each morning in their homeroom.

Parents are allowed to eat lunch with their student(s) as long as they let the teacher know 2 days in advance.

DAILY /WEEKLY COMMUNICATION

- Your student will have a daily folder/binder that will go home every evening. This folder will contain homework assignments for the week.
- -Wednesday Folders will go home every Wednesday with graded papers, important notes, PTO correspondence, etc. Parents/Guardians will be responsible for signing off every Wednesday showing that they review any and all information.

MEDICATION

ALL MEDICATION MUST BE BROUGHT IN BY THE PARENTS/GUARDIAN AND GIVEN TO THE SCHOOL NURSE (NURSE REBECCA) IN ITS ORIGINAL CONTAINER. A FORM MUST BE FILLED OUT. YOU MUST ALSO PICK UP THE MEDICATION AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR OR ELSE IT WILL BE DISPOSED OF BY FC SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT.

EXTENDED SCHOOL PROGRAM (ESP)

The North Lake ESP is available to students for a fee of \$50/week or \$10/day. The hours of operation are from 3:00-6:00 pm. Monday through Friday. There is also a \$15 registration fee . On Early Dismissal Wednesdays, ESP is open from 2:30 pm to 6:00 pm. Breaks and holidays will be offered at specific ESP locations.

Qualified staff members will be scheduled each day but will be under the supervision of the ESP Site Director, Dana Knight. Mrs. Knight has a schedule of planned activities every day including a healthy snack.

Parents interested in after school care may pick-up a registration packet in the school office.
