PERRY KIWANIS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The following information is required to assist the Scholarship Committee in determining award winners:

- A paragraph describing why the student needs the scholarship

- A list of extracurricular activities, community service, honors, and awards during grades 9-12

- A short statement in complete sentences describing the student's educational

- A letter of recommendation for the Kiwanis Club Scholarship from a teacher

- A character letter from a person outside the school

- An official high school transcript

In addition to the above listed requirements, such personal aspects as academic preparation, intellectual ability, attitude, leadership, grade point average, and standardized test scores.

Each scholarship is \$1,750.00 per year as long as the student maintains a 3.0 grade point average. If at any time a 3.0 average is not maintained, the remaining portion of the scholarship will be forfeited. It will be the recipient's responsibility to furnish the chairperson of the Kiwanis Club Scholarship Committee all required documentation including copies of grades each semester completed.

In addition to maintaining a 3.0 grade point average, the student is expected to attend college as a full-time student completing semester hours in a normal progression for completion of his or her selected program of study.

The deadline for submitting the completed application is April $\bf 8$, 2024, to your Guidance Counselor.
