SBAC scores: Student SBAC scores from May 2024 have arrived. Students in grades 4–8 will be bringing them home today in their folders. An explanation of the report, entitled the Connecticut Smarter Balanced Summative Assessment Results, is on one side of the sheet and the student scores on English Language Arts/Literacy and Mathematics are on the other side. Students currently in grade 6 will also be bringing home the Connecticut Next Generation Science Standards Assessment Results, which describes the science standards assessed and provides the student's score
