Virtual School Day Choice Board

If your student is receiving Title 1 services, these are some activities that you can complete to continue to strengthen their reading and writing skills. Each of these activities are optional, however, we would recommend having your student complete one, at the appropriate grade level, in the case of a virtual school day.

Kindergarten	1st Grade	2nd Grade	3rd Grade
Make your own bookmark.	Read your favorite book with a family member.	Build a fort and read a story.	Write a review on a book or movie.
Draw your favorite part of a story.	Make a list of 10 rhyming word pairs.	Draw or write your own story.	Read a book upside down or in a different voice (like a robot or a spooky voice).
Write 10 words with the -at, -an, -am pattern and read aloud to someone.	Practice writing your sight words or spelling words in play dough.	See how many words you can write in 3 minutes, then read them to someone.	Write down 10 addition problems using numbers between 4 and 16, answer them, have someone check your answers, read them outloud 2 times.
Read a book on RAZ, Epic or your own book.	Act out your favorite story.	Read a book on RAZ, Epic or your own book.	Write down the 10 hardest multiplication problems for you, answer them, have someone check your answers, write them again.
