1. Sixth grade English is an intense study of grammar. We use Holt's *Elements of Language* textbook, first course. The four quarters are divided in this way:

- a. Quarter 1 Nouns, Pronouns, and Adjectives
- b. Quarter 2 Verbs, Adverbs, Prepositions, Conjunctions, and Interjections
- c. Quarter 3 Sentences, Fragments, Subjects, Predicates, and Complements
- d. Quarter 4 Phrases and Clauses

2. We have a separate vocabulary lesson periodically throughout each quarter. The lessons will be on Google classroom, and we will have spelling and matching quizzes on each of the lessons.

3. Each student needs to be prepared for class each day. This includes bringing the binder with paper; a laptop, tablet, or cell phone for Google Classroom; pencils and red pens; and other materials as instructed.

4. Tests will be posted on the school's website each week by Monday at noon. Remember that all assignments are subject to change.

6. Students are responsible for all assignments whether they are present or absent. According to the *Southland Handbook*, if a student is absent for one day, one day is allotted to make up the work missed. If a student is absent for more than one day, he or she needs to see me so that we can make arrangements.

7. Grade calculations: daily (26.40%), quizzes – both announced and unannounced (26.40%), tests (27.20%), and quarter exam (20%).

9. Each student is expected to follow all rules as outlined in the *Student Handbook*.

10. This year is a challenging one for students, full of many changes and exciting things. We will all work together to make this a great year!
