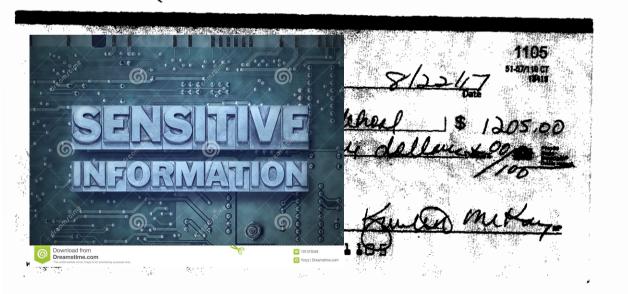

The amount in 2017/2018 we budgeted for Certified Salary turnover savings is \$275,881 and we have met that amount. The Budget Position Listing previously discussed as part of the monthly reports shows an unencumbered amount of \$340,196. This amount is above the already met salary savings of \$275,881.

A portion of that \$340,196 in unencumbered funds will be expended as we fill the remaining three (3) vacant certified positions.
