6. Report from the District

Per Yolanda Ortiz and/or Gary Wuitschick:

- ➤ Ongoing request for recruitment of new members.
- ➤ Reviewed the General Ledger Transactions for District 32, SMJUHS, Fund24/Building Fund, covering the period 7/1/13 to 6/25/14. Although expenditures are coded by category (i.e. professional/consulting services and operating expenses) and school site (PV = 400; Righetti = 500; SM = 700), it is difficult to analyze total construction costs by site, compare these costs to budget, discern state matching contributions, etc. The County provides this information and this is what the District has to work with. A new program will be implemented in the next Fiscal Year, providing each District the ability to create customized reports for analysis.
- ➤ Pertaining to construction (14 classrooms) at Santa Maria High School: Steel erection commencing.
- ➤ Pertaining to the Performing Arts Center at Pioneer Valley High School:

 DSA decision may be taking time due to formal closeout of all other projects (greenhouse, etc.). Consequently, DSA may take another 12-16 weeks for a decision. District is proceeding with timeline, which will be provided at the October committee meeting. Bids are anticipated between now and August.
- ➤ Pertaining to the new board room/training facility at the district office, project is out to bid. Construction is anticipated in September and the District General Fund will finance construction vs. Measure C 2004 bond funds.
- New 25-acre site for the technology school (located in Santa Barbara County vs. the city limits) is in escrow, which may last one year as is it subject to CD review and approval. Cost settled at \$3.6mln.
