ABC / AYP Data Reports

2009-2010 ABC AYP Report was distributed and presented by Dr. Sharon Johnson. Dr. Johnson stated she was very happy with the success of our schools this past year. RCS had 71% of its schools making expected growth compared to 50% the previous year. Dr. Johnson reviewed the following: Comparisons from 2008-2009 through 2009-2010 – ABCs; Performance Composite Comparisons; Graduation Rates; Title I Improvement Results by Subgroup and Grade; Growth and Performance. At the present 21 schools out of 31 made Adequate Yearly Progress. North Carolina Proficiency Target Goals were discussed. New targets go into effect in 2010-2011. Dr. Johnson expressed these type of results are due to the leadership of the Superintendent who has placed staff members in the appropriate places. PLC work is paying off. M. Lambeth, Chair also stated that the gains in the last five years are substantial.

Classified Staff (Bus Drivers)

Jeanne Forrest, Director of Classified Personnel, presented information in regard to bus driving for classified staff. Ms. Forrest shared the following. Bus driving is a condition of employment since August, 1988; classified employees sign as a condition of employment and also sign on the application; Employees hired prior to August 1988 were grandfathered; If hired after 1988 they should have their license or have a medical release form from the State Medical Review Board. It is the Principal or bus

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coordinator's responsibility to sign up employees for bus training. The majority of classified employees have become bus driver certified in the last 22 years. This past year in talking with Principals concerning the RIF policy, Principals were advised to look at criteria such as degrees, longevity, attendance, and evaluations. Ms. Forrest responded to the list that was provided to the board members of individuals at each school that have CDL's. The handwritten notes pertain only to Teacher Assistants. Teacher Assistants were told they were no longer grandfathered. Follow-up is now taking place and an updated list will be distributed. Some Board members expressed concerns of some employees not willing to drive when called upon. Mrs. Forrest stated this should be on their evaluations at the end of the year and after refusal so many times they could be terminated. Sherri Hall and Lisa Thompson, both elementary Principals, spoke of how well a buddy system works at their school sites.
