



Active Consent Text to Include in Registration Forms

Under Tennessee law, active parent/guardian consent is required before students can participate in the student survey. The text below has been approved by the TDOE and should be included in the registration forms parents and guardians complete when enrolling students in any extended learning program. It will be the responsibility of the project director to secure these consents from families, store them, and ensure only students with active consent complete the student survey.

Parent/Guardian Consent to participate in Student Survey

The following text should be included in all participant enrollment forms for 21st CCLC and LEAPs programs and should be discussed at family enrollment meetings.

The Tennessee Department of Education partners with the University of Tennessee Social Work Office of Research and Public Service to evaluate extended learning programs funded by (Nita M. Lowery 21st Century Community Learning Centers /Lottery for Education Afterschool Programs) grants. Part of that evaluation includes a survey for students in grades 3-12. The survey is anonymous: your child will not be asked to provide their name when they complete the survey. The survey asks about your child's experience of the extended learning program and their response will support continued high-quality programming. Please indicate below if you consent to have your child participate in the survey.
