Schools must make adequate yearly progress two years in a row before they are removed from the watch list.

Get a L.I.F.E.

Director of Career and Technical Education Ann Callicutt presented information on a program sponsored by the Asheboro/Randolph Chamber of Commerce and local businesses called Get a L.I.F.E. (Learning is for Earning). The program is designed for middle and high school students and their parents to increase drop out prevention, career awareness, and the important of education in earning a living.

Preliminary 2006-2007 Budget

Finance Officer Todd Lowe presented a copy of the 2006-2007 Preliminary Budget. He reviewed the current expense budget expansion items included in the budget request, which represent a 14.8 percent increase over last year's budget. The Current Expense Budget Request is \$19,093,800. The Capital Outlay Budget Request is \$8,760,000. The Board set Monday, April 24, 2006, at 6 p.m. for a Public Budget Hearing.

Early College Calendar

Assistant Superintendent Russ Gobble presented the 2006-2007 school calendar for the Early College Program. The first day for teachers will be July 31 and for students August 9. The last day of students will be May 21 and for teachers May 25.

School Opening Timelines

Superintendent Donald E. Andrews presented a timeline for opening the new high school for the northeastern area of the county. He stated that during the Board would receive progress reports during the construction phase of the project.
