Peyton wants to be a Lawyer, because she wants to help people.

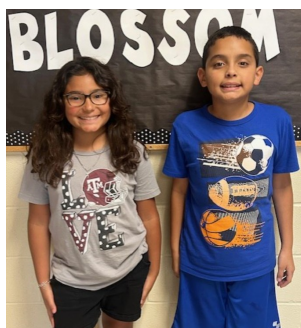
