Adoption of Agenda

T. McDonald made a motion seconded by B. Coltrane that the Board adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried: 7-0.

Instruction

Dr. Sharon Johnson, Director of Testing and Accountability, distributed and reviewed the SAT Report. Dr. Johnson stated that Southwestern Randolph and Eastern Randolph had the largest gains. Trinity High School also had gains, but not as much as previous years. Randleman High and Trinity High had participation rates at or above 50%.

Dremia Meier, Public Relations Director, and Ann Callicutt, Director of Career-Technical Education, presented information and DVD on "Get a L.I.F.E." (Learning Is For Earning) which is an education initiative for all middle and high school students in Randolph County. The program is partnered between Asheboro/Randolph Chamber of Commerce, Randolph Program for the Rural Carolinas and Asheboro City and Randolph County Schools. Some of the programs key goals include: encouraging kids to stay in school, connect kids to skilled and technical careers available in Randolph County and encourage local companies to promote career opportunities within their business and to actively recruit local young people.

Administration

Superintendent Andrews reviewed the school openings and attendance. First day attendance was 18,449, fifth day 18,912 and tenth day 18,937. He reported that on August 27 we experienced severe weather and all 30 schools were under a tornado warning. On August 29 there was a break in a water line in the Randleman area that closed Randleman Elementary for the entire day. Superintendent Andrews reported he had contacted Raleigh and that day will have to be made up.

Superintendent Andrews reported that a Calendar Waiver Request had been completed for Board approval to request an opening date of August 20, 2009 for Wheatmore High School. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Cook to approve Wheatmore High School to open on August 20, 2009. The motion carried: 7-0.

Calendar Committee Appointment

Janet Johnson, Board Member, was appointed to serve on the Calendar Committee.

Fiscal/Operations Planning Committee Appointment

LaVerne Williams, Board Chair, and Becky Coltrane, Vice Chair, were appointed to serve on the Fiscal/Operations Planning Committee.

Wheatmore High School Timelines

Ann Callicutt, Director of Career-Technical Education, and Kim Johnson, Director of Secondary Education distributed and reviewed the timeline for Wheatmore High School. There will be a meeting with the juniors at Trinity High School on Friday, September 19, 2008 concerning high school choice for their senior year.

Operations Update

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, reported that Providence Grove still has some issues that need to be addressed by the contractor – mainly roof leaks and kitchen equipment not working properly. Work is being done to finish up the existing house on the property to use as an Intervention Center. Mr. Trotter reported that at Wheatmore High School major trades are well underway – mechanical; plumbing; electrical and masons. Power should be run on-site within the week. Mr. Trotter also reported the State Superintendent's office had requested each school system to complete a transportation fuel survey. Some school systems are only running yellow buses for regular routes and activity buses for athletic events. An update was given on the air conditioning projects for the high schools. General contractors and their subs are ready to start work and are working on a schedule that will accommodate their work and athletic events in the gym.
