CREATING AND USING YOUR FSAID

What is the FSA ID?

- The FSA ID is a username and password used by students, parents, and borrowers to:
 - login to U.S. Department of Education websites
 - electronically sign documents
- You will use it:
 - Every year you apply for federal student aid at <u>fafsa.gov</u>
 - To receive a federal student loan
 - To perform important activities as a federal student loan borrower, such as choosing a repayment plan or applying for a deferment


Does my parent need an FSA ID?

- If you are a dependent student, then your parent will need an FSA ID in order to sign your FAFSA electronically
- Not sure if you're considered a dependent student for the FAFSA, go to <u>studentaid.gov dependency</u> to find out IMPORTANT
- You and your parent must have different FSA IDs
- You must create your own FSA ID—it's your electronic signature and you need to own it
- Your parent must create his or her own FSA ID
- You and your parent should each use your own email address when creating an FSA ID (you can't use/share the same e-mail address)

How do I create an FSA ID?

- 1. Go to <u>studentaid.gov</u> or scan the QR code
- 2. Click on "Create Account"
