- Support school staff in maintaining school expectations
- Sign and return all documents that require a parent or guardian signature in a timely manner
- Participate in parent-teacher conference opportunities
- Participate in Title 1 feedback opportunities (school compact, family engagement policy, family event surveys)
- Attend school events to show support for your student/school
- Demonstrate mutual respect between parents, teachers/staff, and peers
