Dear Parishioners,

After almost 2 years, we have a Bishop. While I announced it in the bulletin last weekend, I had a chance to meet Bishop Chad Zielinski on Thursday, July 14, (coincidentally the day that Bishop. LeVoir was appointed in 2008, and when I first met him, as well). Bishop Zielinski impressed me as a very

kind, honest, and joyful man.

He is so excited to be assigned here but spoke lovingly of the Diocese of Fairbanks. He will be in for a little culture shock. The Diocese of Fairbanks is 600,000 square miles, versus ours of less than 10,000 square miles. There are about 2 times the priests here, 19 there versus 35 active priests here, serving 40 parishes (some of whom only get Mass once a month) versus about 60 here. As a result, he is very much looking forward to getting to go to our parishes and to interact with all of us -2 hours of driving versus 6+ hours of flying is quite a change.


Bishop Zielinski asked about the current state of our

diocese and parishes and took thorough notes on the answers he received. He noted with sadness the divisions in the church and gave a hint of some of his pastoral priorities to heal these false divisions so that we could be more credible.

He is coming at a good time as the Diocese has just completed the bankruptcy process is now debt-free. I am certain that this will be a burden lifted. As Bishop LeVoir built such a good foundation of healing for those affected by the sin of sexual abuse, Bishop Zielinski will be able to continue this process of rebuilding trust.

As you might recall, we had some storm damage to the trees in the rectory backyard, and it involved some of the shrubs. The shrubs themselves are filled with lots of volunteer trees and are unkempt. I had a contact for stump removal and asked about removing the hedges, and they agreed. At this time, we will simply remove the hedges, the stumps, and have them smooth out the ruts that are quite treacherous to walk on and to mow. The total cost of this project will be about \$1800.
