Where will it be located?

Carpenter Pre-Primary Center, 1407 W Carpenter St, Midland, MI 48640, in room 20.

Age: Birthdate must be on or before June 2nd, 2021

How much will it cost?

\$45/day.

What are the hours of operation?

We will open from 7:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday.

Is there a minimum number of days?

Participants must register for a minimum of 14 days. Monthly registration is required for care. You will receive an email for registration at the beginning of each month. Registration is due no later than the 24th of each month. Without registration care CANNOT be provided.

Any credit to an account will be at the discretion of Greater Midland. If you register for a day and do not attend, you are still responsible for payment.

Do we need to sign our children in and out?

All students must be signed in when arriving at care. For the safety of the students, only persons listed on the authorized pickup section of enrollment form may sign a student out. <u>Picture identification may be</u> required when signing students out of care.

Do you provide food?

FREE BREAKFAST AND LUNCH! AVAILABLE TO ALL CHILDREN AND THE PUBLIC.

Monday-Friday, the Meet Up and Eat Up program provides children with the opportunity to eat breakfast and lunch, at no charge.

We will provide a morning and afternoon snack.

Families who wish to pack their own lunch will need to make sure it is equipped with an ice pack; microwaves will be available. Children with dietary restrictions will work with the site lead to make appropriate accommodations.

What should our children bring?

A backpack with the following items labeled:

- A water bottle
- Extra set of clothes
- Swimsuit and Towel
- Sunscreen
- Appropriate Shoes

Do you provide transportation to other camps?

We do not provide transportation to and from different sites.

Do you allow electronics?

Electronics will not be allowed onsite.
