The ATL skills are deliberate strategies, skills, and attitudes that permeate the IB teaching and learning environment. The ATLs consists of five categories of interrelated skills and associated sub skills that support students of all ages to become self-regulated learners. The five categories are communication, research, thinking, social skills, and self-management. The teachers will plan for implicit and explicit opportunities using a variety of strategies to develop the ATL both inside and outside the Programme of Inquiry to influence your child's education not on just what your child learns but how your child learns it.

Finally, we are so proud of the number of awards given each week! Our goal to shine with the Lake Wales Charter School Read 20 literacy initiative is happening and we want to thank you for all your support. Please continue to read each night for twenty minutes and have your child attend each day. We can't wait to host our glow party for our next AR celebration. Classroom News

Kindergarten

November is going to be such an exciting month in Kindergarten! November 7th will be our first Field trip of the year where we will be visiting the Harvest Holler in Plant City and our Fall Fest on November 17th. In social studies, students have been learning about being responsible citizens and we can't wait to see them put this knowledge into action during our field trip. In Dance, our Kindergarteners are learning new songs for their December Holiday performance so please encourage them to practice at home. Quick reminder to all families that homework is due every Friday and it is crucial all students are taking the time to practice the skills they've learned during the day while at home doing their homework. Practice makes perfect and we know our students are capable of great things.

First Grade

In First Grade for the month of November in ELA, the students are learning to form and write complex sentences along with using proper nouns and appropriate capitalization. We are stressing the importance of learning sight words and to continue reading for 20 minutes every day. In Math the students are sharpening their computation skills, by learning to make a 10, using doubles facts, and using a number line to solve and dissect word problems. In Science, they are observing living and nonliving things and will begin learning the plant life cycle. In Social Studies, the students are being exposed to community workers, historical events and how that relates to the present times. Please encourage your child to read the directions on their homework and retell the stories that are sent home. It is so important that our students begin reading for understanding and not just for knowing the words.

Second Grade

It's November and students are falling into the groove of second grade! Our new transdisciplinary theme is Sharing Our Planet. Students will gain knowledge about the basic needs of living and nonliving things. Within this new unit, students will learn how to solve two-digit addition problems, with and without regrouping. Second graders enjoy learning about Fables and are able to summarize a story using the plot of the story. We look forward to entertaining our families and friends on November 7th, in honor of Veterans Day. Students are excited to show their loved ones how hard we are working here at JHW.

Third Grade

In the month of November, third grade will be moving into our transdisciplinary unit of "how we organize ourselves". Throughout this unit we will be focusing on Earth and Space across all subjects. In ELA, the students will be working with figurative language and using their inferencing skills to better understand the text. In Math, the students are continuing to work hard on their Multiplication skills and learning strategies along with the 5 different properties and relating all of those skills to division. In Science, the students will be working on their earth space standards and learning all about the world around us and the importance of the sun. In Social Studies, the students will be working on the physical systems of the United States and focusing on the different characteristics of the different regions. Please continue to encourage your child to read nightly and encourage them to write about what they have read to deepen their understanding of the text and sharpen their writing skills.

Fifth Grade

For the month of September in Math, students will be learning about rounding and compatible numbers to estimate the product of a decimal and a whole number, as well as using place value understanding and an algorithm for multiplying whole numbers and decimals. We will be continuously practicing our math facts and encourage students and their families to practice them at home. In ELA, we will be focusing on text structure, text features, and figurative language. Students should be reading at least 20 minutes a day and recording a summary in their homework journals. We are really wanting students to focus on Reading Plus as this is a program that is proven to push them to the next level. This is done in class daily and can also be completed at home as well. We will be finishing our unit on argumentative writing and moving into expository writing. In Science and PYP we will be learning about where we are in place and time. Our central idea is identity forms through perception of values. We will be learning about renewable and nonrenewable resources, weathering and erosion, the water cycle, factors influencing weather, and weather in environments and climate zones and more. In Social Studies and Writing, students will be finishing their Daughter's of the American Revolution Essay (due November 1 st). Following the Daughter's of the American Revolution Essay, students will be working on the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Oratorical Contest. The theme is "Living the Dream: It Starts with Me – Spreading Hope, Courage, and Unity." The speech is due December 11 th . Please support and encourage your students to complete their homework each night. Mrs. Sotomayor (math) has a math folder where homework is to be completed. Mrs. Maldonado (ELA) and Dr. Klepacki science/social studies) share ONE homework journal. ELA and Science/Social Studies is to be completed in the student's homework journal. Homework is to be completed each night! Teachers check for homework every day! Thank you to the parents that have signed up to be a volunteer! 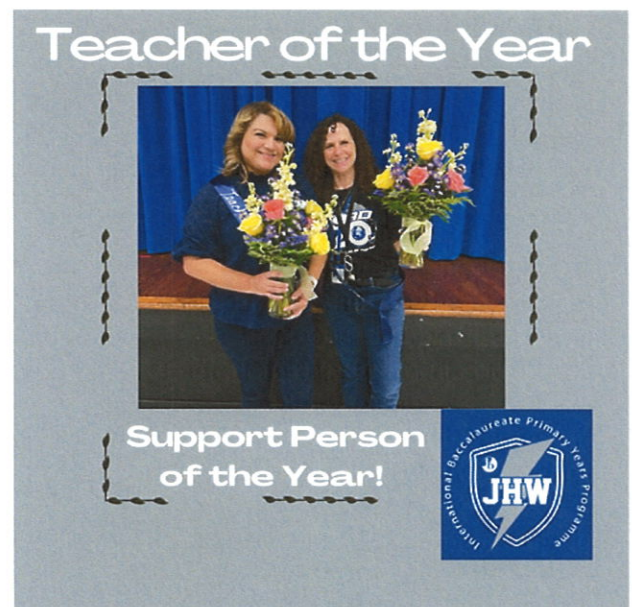

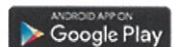

Behavior Tips

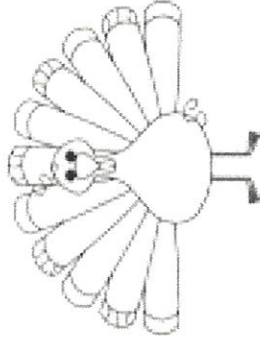
Keep promises



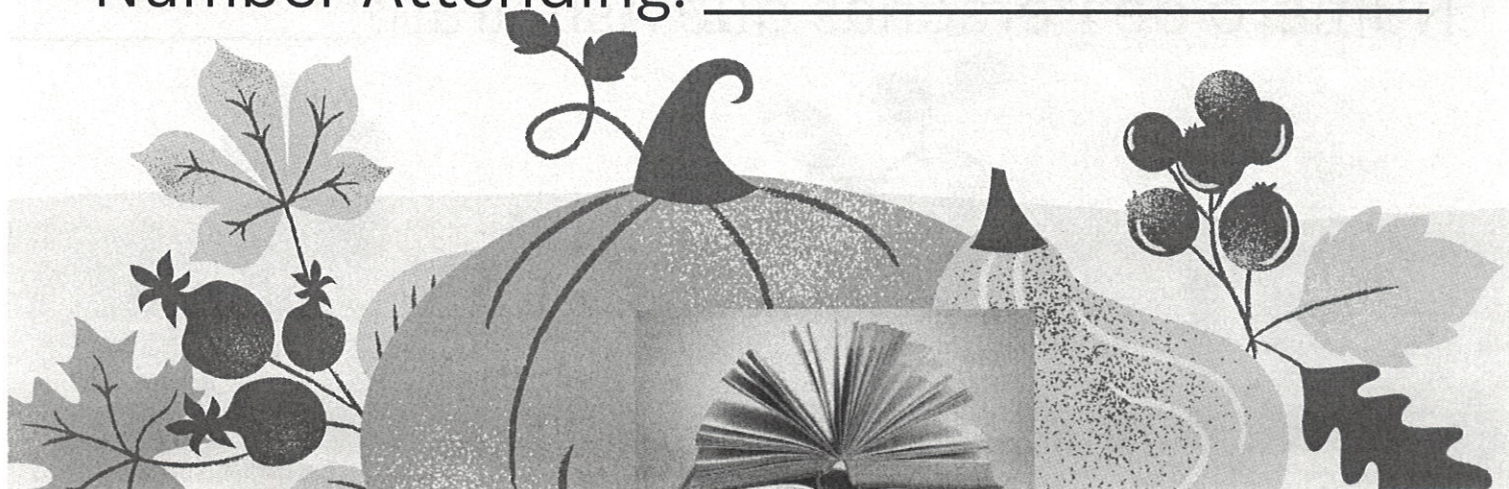
