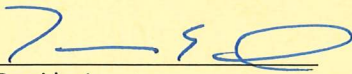

Comments from the Public on Agenda:

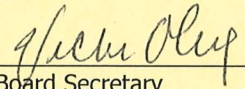
1. Amanda Shaporka – Worried about any sexually misconduct and would like to know that modifications, if any, the school has made to help keep it from happening at Frazier?
