

Western Line Collegiate Academy - Quick Reference Sheet

Program Purpose:

- Partnership between Western Line School District (WLSD) and Mississippi Delta Community College (MDCC).
- Students graduate with both a high school diploma and an associate degree or industry certification.
- Up to 60 college credits transferable to universities.

Who Can Participate:

- Apply in 10th grade for 11th–12th grade participation.
- Minimum GPA 3.0, ACT: English 17, Math 19.
- Teacher recommendation (English or Math).
- Meet dual enrollment requirements, show maturity and good conduct.

Program Features:

- Classes at O'Bannon HS, Riverside HS, GHEC, MDCC campuses/online.
- Participate in high school extracurriculars (no college athletics).
- Access to MDCC faculty, tutoring, and advising.
- WLSD covers tuition, fees, books, transportation, and meals.

Expectations:

- Maintain 2.0+ college GPA, meet attendance requirements.
- Follow WLSD and MDCC Codes of Conduct.
- Dismissal possible for discipline issues or persistent noncompliance.

Transportation & Attendance:

- WLSD provides buses; students may drive (no non-sibling carpool).
- Attend Mon–Thu at MDCC, Fri at home school.
- Different calendars mean classes may occur when WLSD is closed.

Other Key Points:

- Uniform: Royal blue or gold polo, navy/khaki bottoms, district lanyard with MDCC ID.
- Eligible for graduation honors (Valedictorian/Salutatorian).
- Meals provided by WLSD Child Nutrition Office.
