The instructor is responsible for all aspects of the majorette team including teaching baton twirling and dance to students and providing for the coaching, recruitment, and retention of students participating as members of the majorette team. The selected candidate will work with participants to improve personal and teamwork skills and to promote student growth and development by developing choreographic routines and baton twirling skills. The majorette coach is also required to continue professional development to maintain an understanding of current majorette trends and twirling techniques.
