# Science Binder

We will be using a Science Binder for this class. Classwork will be kept in your binder and your binder will serve as a study guide along with digital assignments when preparing for a test or a quiz. When taking a Chapter test, your binder will be turned in for 100 points. You are responsible for keeping your binder neat and organized.

# Bellwork

Bellwork will be assigned each day and you are responsible for completing this assignment as soon as you get settled into the classroom. Bellwork assignments will be graded (25 points) each Monday for the previous week. Bellwork will be completed and recorded in your spiral notebook.

# **Test Schedule**

Please refer to Goal Sheets, Checklist, and the website for each week's testing schedule. Please note that this is a tentative schedule and could possibly change depending on the mastery of skills.

#### **Attendance**

Regular attendance is essential to the progress of a student. This is necessary to stay current with all the daily work. When students are absent, it is their responsibility to complete the work they missed. We encourage parents to call or send an email to the school in the morning in order to notify us if you know your child is going to be absent.

Please read over the attendance policy in the NMCS Family Handbook for any additional questions. Please remember the maximum number of days that a student may miss a class and still receive credit for the course is twenty (20) days. Of the 20 absences, only seven (7) days may be excused by parents' notes, after which a doctor's excuse is required. The Principal, based on the value of the absences, will make final determination of class credit. It is important to note the 20 days include both excused and unexcused absences.
