Dear Parishioners.

We are honored to welcome Fr. Joe Laramie with us this weekend as he preaches the Diocesan Eucharistic Revival Series, as well as offer the Masses in our parishes for this second Sunday of Lent. I hope many, not only from our parishes but from far and wide, will come to hear a message of the great gift of the Eucharist and grow in our reverence and appreciation of the Eucharist.

Last Monday, I had a regular checkup with the gastroenterologist in Mankato. Even though I was just there for a 'procedure' in September, I needed to be seen again to update my medication for my colitis. I had an incident of my stomach issues, and because I immediately took something for it, by the time I got into the doctor, I was fine. T be honest, though, I had a few other flare-ups since, but OTC medication seems to help eventually. While in Mankato, I visited with my sisters as we marked 2 years since my Mom's passing.

This weekend, we hear of the Transfiguration. It might seem

odd to read this in Lent, as it most likely occurred in August (around the Feast of Booths). The Transfiguration hints at something important to remember during our Lenten fast. Jesus

Christ is not a mere man – He is God-made-man.

He is not a man who is made a god, either. His transfiguration reveals His divinity, ever so briefly, to give the Apostles Peter, James, and John a sense of hope. Perhaps on the morning of the resurrection, the memory of what they witnessed on that holy mount helped them to muster the courage to run to the tomb to see what happened. Perhaps the glory St. John witnessed gave him the strength to stand at the foot of the cross in solemn vigil with the Blessed Mother.

As we travel through our Lent, we cannot allow the scandal of the cross detract from the glory of the One who so willingly mounted it for our salvation. We need the Transfiguration to

mounted it for our salvation. We need the Transfiguration to remind us that Jesus really is God who has taken on flesh for us.

On Monday, I received a call from Tekton Ministries, the pilgrimage company I hoped to book a pilgrimage through for this September. Due to the situation in the Holy Land, I am rescheduling for 2025. We will hopefully be able to leave September 16, 2025, and return September 26 (leaving on a Tuesday and returning on a Friday). The itinerary will remain the same. Part of the reason is that even if the conflict ended immediately, there is a lack of hotels for pilgrims as they are currently occupied by displaced people. I was given the option of relocation, but none of the options appealed to me.




