DIPLOMATYPES

REGULAR DIPLOMA:

- 24 CREDITS MINIMUM
- ENGLISH 9, 10, 11, AND 12
- WORLD HISTORY, UNITED STATES HISTORY 10, UNITED STATES HISTORY 11, US GOVERNMENT, AND ECONOMICS
- GEOMETRY, ALGEBRA I, ALGEBRA II, MATH ELECTIVE
- PHYSICAL SCIENCE, BIOLOGY, TWO SCIENCE ELECTIVES
- BEGINNING KINESIOLOGY (ROTC, MARCHING BAND/AUXILLARIES, DANCE, VARISTY ATHLETICS, SHOW CHOIR)
- CAREER PREP (ROTC LEADERSHIP AND FOUNDATIONS/NJROTC 1)

HONORS DIPLOMA:

- 26 CREDITS MINIMUM

- HR, AP, IB, DE WORLD HISTORY, UNITED STATES, UNITED STATES HISTORY, US GOVERNMENT, AND ECONOMICS
- HR, AP, IB, DE GEOMETRY, ALGEBRA I, ALGEBRA II, MATH ELECTIVE
- HR, AP, IB, DE BIOLOGY, CHEMISTRY, PHYSICS, SCIENCE ELECTIVE
- BEGINNING KINESIOLOGY (ROTC, MARCHING BAND/AUXILLARIES, DANCE, VARSITY ATHLETICS, SHOW CHOIR)
- CAREER PREP (ROTC LEADERSHIP AND FOUNDATIONS/NJROTC 1)
- HEALTH EDUCATION (FOUNDATIONS OF HEALTH SCIENCE)
- THREE ELECTIVE COURSES FROM CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE), FINE ARTS (FA), AND/OR FOREIGN LANGUAGE (FL)
- PARTS ONE AND TWO OF THE SAME FOREIGN LANGUAGE
- MUST HAVE A WEIGHTED GPA OF 3.5 OR HIGHER AT THE END OF SENIOR YEAR



ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Earn A College and Career Readiness Indicator or a Credential

- Earn a benchmark on at least ONE subtest of the ACT.

 | ENGLISH | READING | MATH | SCIENCE |
- Earn a three(3) or higher on at least one Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate Test.
- Earn a credit through Dual Enrollment (Technical or Academic) course.
- Earn a credential or certification through taking a Career and Technical Education course and passing the certification examination.
- Enlist in the United States Military.
- Score a 4 or higher on each section of the ACT Workkeys Test.
- Complete the required three (3) course sequence in one chosen pathway (includes ROTC).

Have An Approved Four-Year Educational Plan

All MCPSS students are required to create a Four-Year Educational Plan in 8th grade. During their high school tenure, the students will work with their grade level counselor to review, update, and approve the plan yearly. The plan will be reviewed and updated during Individual Student Planning sessions. By senior year, students are required to have approved plans for each year of high school.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Successfully pass the State of Alabama Civics Test

To be completed after taking US Government during Senior year. Students must score 60% or higher to pass. Retests are given to students who fail.

Complete And Submit the FAFSA Application

To be completed between October 1st - April 30th of Senior Year. Any senior who declares non-intent to enroll in college, will be required to complete waiver with parent signature.







Senior Checklist

All Seniors will receive a checklist that contains the following information:

- FSA ID Created
- FAFSA Completed
- Four-Year Plan
- Civics Test

Senior Ranking System
Class of 2025 and After Valedictorian

Class of 2025 and After Valedictorian and Salutatorian Only Seniors will be ranked by Honor for Academic Achievement.

Summa Cum Laude -4.0 and above.

Magna Cum Laude - 3.50 - 3.99

Cum Laude - 3.00-3.49

Students must meet the requirements for the Diploma with Advanced Honors Endorsement to be recognized as Summa or Magna Cum Laude.

This system is designed to allow more students to be recognized for their academic achievements regardless of their diploma track.





Senior Procedures

Letters of Recommendation

- Complete Senior Profile
- Complete LOR Request Link found on Senior Schoology Page.
 - Student's Name
 - Name of Agency, School, or
 Organization requesting a letter
 - Purpose of letter (scholarship, admissions, military, etc.)
 - Date letter is needed
 - Any special instructions or requests for information needed in letter.

Transcript Request

- Requests must be enter into Need My Transcript.
- A link to access Need My
 Transcript will be placed in the
 Senior Schoology folder and on
 the DHS website.



Senior Procedures

ACT/SAT FEE WAIVERS

- Only 11th and 12th Grade students can use a waiver.
- Waivers can be used during the ACT/SAT testing year (Oct. - Sept.)
- Students can use four waivers per testing year.
- Students can sign for a waiver in the School Counselor's Office.
- Students are required to photograph the waiver to maintain a copy of the number.

COLLEGE APPLICATION FEE WAIVERS

- A Copy of the ACT College
 Application Fee Waiver can be obtained on the Senior Schoology
 Page.
- Each college or university has the autonomy to decide if they will accept application fee waivers.
 THEY ARE NOT REQUIRED TO DO SO!!!
- The waiver must be signed by Dr.
 Walker and emailed to the school's Admissions Office.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- Scholarships will be posted in a Senior Schoology folder and posted on Remind.
- Reminders about deadlines will be sent via Remind.
- Please be mindful of deadlines.
- Please join the Warrior Scholars Group to receive assistance with scholarship applications and college application completion. Warrior Scholarship will be after school and develop a calendar of meeting days and times.


