### **Superintendent's Comments**

#### **Routine items**

During this meeting, we approved the Proposed Budget for FY23, after holding a Public Hearing on the Budget. Seniority lists were approved for teachers, bus drivers and monitors, and support staff. These have been updated and looked over by the staff to confirm accuracy. Finally, we shared our school improvement goals

for the year for elementary and JH/HS, along with district-wide goals. Building level goals are derived from the instructional teams and the district goals were taken from staff survey results conducted by the Regional Office of Education.

### **New Roof**

The school board approved the lowest bid to replace the roof on the 2000 edition of the school building. This bid process was overseen by the school architect from Klingner and Associates. Tournear Roofing, who is local, was the lowest bid and recommended for approval by the architect.

### **Miscellaneous**

The school board approved stipends for the sponsors of Bass Fishing Club and E-sports. Also, an agreement with AirMed was approved, so staff could receive discounted rates.

### **Maintenance Grant FY23**

The Liberty School Board approved applying for a \$50,000 maintenance grant that will be matched with \$50,000 from Tort Funds to repave an area in the elementary parking lot. These funds will not cover the entire lot, but it will take care of a section. Future maintenance grants can help us re-pave other areas of the parking lot.

Reports and updates were given by the Principals, Superintendent, Technology Director, Transportation Director, and the AD/Dean of Students.
