Re: Termination of Delegate Agency Agreement

Dear Delegate:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of upcoming changes that will be made in the Head Start/Early Head Start program serving West Central Missouri. Additionally, this letter is to serve as formal notice of our intent to terminate the agreement between Community Development Institute Head Start ("CDI HS") and Calhoun R-IIIV School District ("Delegate").

As you likely know, for the past three years CDI HS has had the responsibility for interim management of Head Start/Early Head Start program operations in West Central Missouri.

On June 1, 2022, you entered into a contract/agreement with CDI HS for the purpose of assigning to Delegate part of CDI HS's responsibility for operating a Head Start program (the "Agreement"). As you may recall, while CDI HS has had responsibility for management of the program on an interim basis, the Office of Head Start (OHS) engaged in a process to identify a permanent local recipient. The new recipient has now been awarded this grant by OHS. Therefore, on October 1, 2022, the administration of the program will be the responsibility of the new recipient, and CDI HS's funding for operation of the program will end.

As CDI HS will no longer be funded as the interim recipient for the Delegate Program service area, CDI HS hereby exercises its right to terminate the Agreement. Due to the timing of this funding notice so near to the commencement of the new school year, CDI HS has made the decision that we will not serve children under the Delegate Agreement, effective immediately. CDI HS will work with Delegate to transition children who would have returned this school year to an alternative slot. Delegate may submit reasonable closeout costs incurred through August 15, 2022, which shall be submitted to CDI HS no later than September 15, 2022.

Dear Parents, Guardians and Community Members:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of upcoming changes to the Head Start and Early Head Start programs. For the past three years, the administration of the Head Start program and grant awardee has been the responsibility of the Community Development Institute Head Start (CDI HS), located in Denver, Colorado. CDI HS assumed responsibility for managing the operations of the program to ensure continuity of services to Head Start and Early Head Start children and families at a time when the local grantee could no longer operate the program.

During this interim period, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) launched a process to identify a permanent grantee. DHHS has awarded this grant to a new recipient. Therefore, the administration of the Head Start program will be transferred to the new recipient, who will then have the responsibility of awarding future grants to programs and our agreement is terminated immediately.

What this means is that Head Start will no longer fund the Calhoun Schools, Clinton Schools Early Childhood programs and many other programs they were funding in the West Central Missouri area. The funding we received at Calhoun was \$357,000 annually and that amount paid for over eighty percent (80%) of all operating cost for the Early Childhood Head Start program. Without the federal Head Start grant funds there is no way to remain open or make up that kind of funding from local or state tax dollars we get for the K-12 buildings. The Early Childhood Center is not funded by anything outside of Head Start and parent tuition payments. We do not receive any other federal, state or local funding for the Early Childhood Center.

Due to this change, there will be immediate changes to the Calhoun Early Childhood Education Head Start services. Your child will no longer continue to receive Head Start services at the same location they were previously attending and will have to apply for services at an alternate location through Head Start. Due to these changes and lack of funding, we will not be opening the Early Childhood Center for the 2022-23 school year. We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, but we were just notified of these changes as well by the Office of Head Start.
