

Baccalaureate Scholarship Application — a life-changing opportunity for Washington students — is now open!

The Baccalaureate Scholarship provides up to \$22,500 in financial aid, mentorship, and career resources to students pursuing high-demand careers in STEM and health care in Washington state.

Key Benefits for Students:

- Scholarships of up to \$22,500 to cover tuition, fees, and expenses.
- Access to mentorship programs and career-building networks.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Washington state resident. WSOS accepts undocumented students.
- Plan to pursue or be currently pursuing a bachelor's degree in an <u>eligible STEM</u> or health care major at an <u>eligible Washington state college or university</u>.
- Have a family income that does not exceed 125% of <u>Washington state median</u> <u>family income</u>. Example: a family of four may not exceed \$164,000 per year.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Washington Application for State Financial Aid (WASFA) by the application deadline (February 26, 2025, at 9:00 p.m. PST).
 - If this date is not feasible for your student, please work 1:1 with your <u>student</u> <u>to complete ASAP</u>, and let us know at <u>info@waopportunityscholarship.org</u>.
- Students must have their most recent high school or GED transcripts reflecting a 2.75 GPA (they can be unofficial).
 - If students haven't completed their GED yet, they can check a box in the application indicating that they will provide scores by June 30.
