1. Resolved, that the Board of Trustees approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on Tuesday, November 15, 2016. Mr. Geisewite moved, seconded by Ms. Rossman. Motion passed (6-0).

- 4. Resolved, that the Board of Trustees approve Brian Stugart as Secondary Administrator effective July 1, 2016. Mr. Ruhl moved, seconded by Ms. Garverick. Motion passed (6-0).
- 5. Resolved, that the Board of Trustees approve Lori Bair as a substitute Teacher at a rate of \$120.00 per day, effective November 23, 2016. Mr. Geisewite moved, seconded by Mr. Ruhl. Motion passed (6-0).
- 6. Resolved, that the Board of Trustees approve Jim Phoenix as Maintenance at a rate of \$11.00 per hour with benefits, effective November 23, 2016. Ms. Garverick moved, seconded by Mr. Rossman. Motion passed (6-0).
