LENTEN DAY OF SERVICE has been changed to April 1st due to the Requiem Mass for Doug Blacom. We will meet at 8am. Lunch will be provided. Let's all work together to clean our Church and campus for Holy Week and Easter.

SWIECONKA (sh-vee-en-soon-kah) is a Polish tradition where Baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday. The basket is traditionally lined with a white linen or lace napkin and decorated with sprigs of boxwood (*bukszpan*), the typical Easter evergreen. This food is shared on Easter morning in a ritual breaking of the fast. Fr. Weis will bless baskets after the Vigil Mass for anyone who wishes to participate. Bishop Steven Raica will bless baskets at the Cathedral of St. Paul on Holy Saturday, April 8th at 9:00 am. All are welcome.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Stations of the Cross will be prayed each Friday in Lent at 6:30 pm.

HOLY THURSDAY ADORATION: After the Mass of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday, April 6^{th} , there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the chapel until 11:00 pm. There should be at least one person in the chapel at all times. There is a sign-up sheet in the narthex.
