### GAME 2

## BANDERA (1-0) AT INGRAM (0-1)

WARRIOR FIELD, 7 P.M. SEPT. 6, 2024

In the first meeting between Bandera and Ingram Tom Moore in seven years, the Warriors will look to snap a historic losing streak against the visiting Bulldogs, who own an eight-game winning streak in the series dating to 2005.

Bandera is coming off a 10-win season in 2023 and opened the 2024 campaign with a 29-22 win over Poteet. Bandera needed a fourth-quarter touchdown to seal the win. The Bulldogs have reached the UIL playoffs in three of the last four seasons in the 4A. The last time the Bulldogs and Ingram played, Bandera won 27-22.

Ingram is coming off a sluggish start in a 29-6 loss to visiting Crystal City, but the Javelinas showed some offensive grit with ball control. Thanks to 18 penalties, primarily for holding, the visiting Javelinas could hog the ball for more than 60 offensive plays, keeping the Warriors defense on the field for long stretches. Ingram also turned the ball over three times, leading to three Crystal City touchdowns. The Warriors had two red-zone opportunities and a third inside the Crystal City 35-yard line. Regardless of the outcome, Ingram received strong performances from:

- Senior quarterback Kye Hightower scored on a 3-yard touchdown and rushed for 95 yards. Hightower has scored a touchdown in 13 consecutive games. Hightower has 43 career touchdowns.
- Sophomore quarterback Logan Spalding was 4-of-10 passing for 80 yards, with a 48-yard completion to Bowdoin Zipp, who had a magnificent game on both sides of the ball. Zipp led the Warriors with nine solo tackles and an interception.
- Senior running back Peyton Middleton rushed for 56 yards and two solo tackles.
- Junior defensive lineman Zac Harder had a tackle for a loss.
- Sophomore defensive back Will Symm had a tackle for a loss.
- Christian Carranza connected on a 33-yard field goal to give the Warriors their first points of the season.
- This is the last game before the Warriors embark on a three-game road trip against Comfort, Blanco and Brady.
