

**Board Policy JBCA: Resident Students**

## STUDENT ASSIGNMENT

The Fannin County Board of Education is authorized by state law to designate school attendance zones within the Fannin County School District.

All children residing in Fannin County and attending the Fannin County Schools are required to attend the appropriate school in the attendance zone in which they live with their parents or guardians.

Notwithstanding any of the foregoing provisions, if a student's residence changes within Fannin County and the new residence is located in a different attendance zone, the student may complete the school year at the school in which he or she is enrolled. Before the beginning of the next school year, however, the student should transfer to the appropriate school serving the student's new residence unless a request is granted in accordance with District transfer procedures.

Transportation will not be provided to any student attending an out-of-zone school.
