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Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Frazier School District was given permission to offer *Flexible Instruction Days* by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. For the 2021-2022 school year, we are planning to utilize *Flexible Instruction Days* when inclement weather would impact students traveling to school.

The District will have three (3) options when inclement weather affects a school day:

- School Delay
- Flexible Instruction Day
- Closed Day

On *Flexible Instruction Days*, students will remain at home and log into their Google Classrooms and follow their regular remote schedule as listed in the Remote Instruction/ FID document that is included with this correspondence. Students will participate virtually and interact through Google Meet or Zoom. In addition, students will be able to access their assignments or homework via Google Classroom, or previously provided paper assignments from your child's teacher.

On *Flexible Instructional Days* teachers will be available during their designated office hours via school email, google meet, or by phone to in order to support students and parents with classroom assignments.

Students will have two (2) school days to complete assignments for the *Flexible Instruction Day;* which will enable them to be marked present (for attendance purposes) for the day. **Remember, this day will count as a regular day of school.**

When the District designates a *Flexible Instruction Day*, the School Messenger system will notify parents/students and local television stations will announce the *Flexible Instruction Day*.
