ACCOUNTABILITY/COMMITMENT TO ACCOMPLISHMENT

Centennial BOCES Accountability Committee

The Centennial BOCES accountability committee (CBAC) shall consist of at least:

three parents of students enrolled in Centennial BOCES school(s)

one teacher employed by Centennial BOCES

- one school administrator employed by Centennial BOCES
- one person who is involved in business or industry in the community within Centennial BOCES's boundaries

A person may not serve in more than one of the required membership roles on the CBAC. A person who is employed by Centennial BOCES or related to a Centennial BOCES employee shall not be eligible to serve as a parent on the CBAC. "Related" means the person's spouse, son, daughter, sister, brother, mother or father. If, however, the Centennial BOCES makes a good faith effort and is unable to identify a sufficient number of parents that meet these criteria, a person may serve as a parent on the CBAC and also be employed by Centennial BOCES or related to a Centennial BOCES employee.

The Board shall appoint persons to the CBAC. In making these appointments, the Board shall ensure, to the extent practicable, that the parents appointed reflect the student populations significantly represented within Centennial BOCES.

If the Board chooses to increase the number of persons on the CBAC, it shall ensure that the number of parents appointed exceeds the number of representatives from the group with the next highest representation.

Members of the CBAC will serve terms of two years. The CBAC shall select a parent representative to serve as chair or co-chair, who shall serve terms of two years. The CBAC shall also establish a schedule of meetings and adopt general rules for its operation.
