POSITION TITLE: TEACHER-SECONDARY CAREERS

JOB DESCRIPTION: (Synopsis, full position description upon request)

Student Work Experience:

- Coordinates employer and school partners for the purpose of meeting the work education objectives.
- Counsels students/interns in job search skills for the purpose of informing them of employment and career options.
- Monitors students' performance in a variety of work sites according to program guidelines (e.g. visits to job sites, obtain employer evaluations, serves as a liason between employer and students, etc.)

Career Development/Curriculum:

- Provides teachers and students with references and supplementary materials that will support and enrich the curriculum; provides career awareness for all students.
- Develops pre-employment and employment skill lessons following the selected career curriculum (e.g. Virtual Job Shadow, Internet Inventory Assessment, etc.)
- Assists Transition Coordinator, teachers and related staff for the purpose of supporting lessaon plans and/or developing students' career skills.

Assists Transition Coordinator with all transitional needs of the students.

Kansas Student Transition and Readiness (KSTAR) Development/Curriculum:

- Collaborates with the Independent Living Supervisor. Focus on independent living skills improvement.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Qualify for Kansas certification by KSDE for assigned level and area. Fluency in American Sign Language (ASL). Applicants must be <u>pre-approved</u> for certification via KS Dept. of Education, Cert. Dept. prior to the issuing of a contract. (ASL and writing skills will be assessed.)

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Upon offer of employment: official transcripts are required, a background check will be conducted via the KS Bureau of Investigation, Backgrounds Plus consents, Kansas Department of Children and Family Services, National Sex Offender Listing and Work Reference consent. Also, a Tuberculosis test & Health Certificate must be passed upon offer of employment (cost borne by employee).

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Open Until Filled. Send resume and copies of all college transcripts. Send (3) letters of recommendation. For consideration request an official KSD application or go to our website and submit application for KSD review.
