Ingram Jr. FFA for 6th & 7th Graders

Students MUST attend Ingram Middle School to participate in Ingram Jr. FFA.

ONLY younger siblings of Regular FFA or Jr. FFA members attending Ingram Elementary will be allowed to exhibit livestock under Ingram FFA; these elementary students will NOT be able to participate in teams.

Livestock:

- High School FFA members WILL have precedence in the Ingram school barn over Jr. FFA members.
- All students exhibiting livestock under Ingram FFA MUST attend 4 of the 5 scheduled monthly FFA meetings to show under Ingram FFA.
- Parents and exhibitors MUST attend the major show entry meeting to sign up for livestock shows.
- ALL students showing under Ingram FFA WILL stall together at County, Grandstand, San Angelo, and San Antonio if an FFA Advisor is in attendance... **there will be NO exceptions!** If you do not agree to this, your child is welcome to show under one of the 4-H chapters.
- If you have someone assisting your child with feeding, showing, etc... they are NOT to give advice to or influence other Ingram FFA showmen or their families. If they have suggestions or constructive criticism, they may speak directly to an Ingram FFA Advisor. (Please see additional guidelines in the Ingram Barn Agreement for students' housing projects at the Ingram ISD Barn)
