Dear St. Anne Parents,

It has been a positive start to the month of February. After last week, it has been wonderful to have a full week of school without any snow days, flexible instruction days, or two-hour delays. Thank you to our students and families for your cooperation and support during our second flexible instruction day. Your flexibility and partnership help ensure that learning continues smoothly, even when the weather does not cooperate. At this time, we have used all of our built-in snow days and have three of our five flexible instruction days remaining for the school year.

At Mass today, students received the Blessing of the Throats in honor of St. Blaise. This special tradition involves the use of two crossed candles as a prayer for protection against throat ailments and illnesses through the intercession of the fourth-century bishop and martyr. It was a meaningful way to reflect on our faith and care for one another as a school community.

Students will attend Mass on Wednesday, February 18 for Ash Wednesday, and again on February 20 and 27. In addition, students will attend Stations of the Cross on Wednesday, February 25. Students will be dismissed at 11:45 a.m. There will be no school on Monday, February 16 in observance of Presidents' Day.




