#### WHAT IS IT?

This is a plan that describes how Sharp Creek Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. #### HOW IS IT TZEVISED?

Sharp Creek Elementary School invited all parents to view our Annual Schoolwide Title I Meeting, in person, on July 28, 2022, as well as provide feedback via the Title I Parent and Stakeholder Input Meeting on September 1, 2022 and throughout the month by accessing the virtual feedback form. The Teacher and Parent Engagement Team also met to review and revise this parent and family engagement policy, as well as the schoolwide plan, our school-parent compact, and the family engagement budget. Additionally, parent input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year through an online form. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and submit feedback throughout the year. All parent feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online and by mail to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during several parent meetings and activities during the school year including our annual Community Cares event. #### WHO IS IT FOR?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Sharp Creek Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and of migratory children.

Sharp Creek Elementary will take the following measures to promote and support parents and family members as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals. We will:

Staff will also share best practices during regularly scheduled faculty meetings.
- Partner with early childhood programs, middle and high schools, college and career ready resources or organizations, parent resource centers, or other programs (as applicable) to help prepare parents and their children for successful school transitioning.
- Share information on the school website, newsletter, and social media for parents to understand the school's academic standards and assessments as well as the ways parents can monitor their child's progress and work with educators.
- Inform parents of student assessment results individually during parent teacher conferences held at least twice a year (October and March). Provide interpreters as needed.
- Work with our parents to develop relevant trainings and helpful presentations to educate our staff on the importance of parent and family engagement and how to support student learning.
- Provide necessary materials and handouts for parents at conferences, meetings, and activities to help parents work with their child to improve their child's achievement.

Sharp Creek Elementary believes that family engagement means the participation of parents and family members in regular two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring:

- Parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning.

- The carrying out of other activities as described in this plan.


