Administrative Procedures

Enrollment of Students Released from Incarceration

Conditional Release Students

The district requires students on conditional release to attend an alternative school placement before being allowed to return to a traditional school setting. However, their placement at an alternative school is not guaranteed if the student has not completed a recent expulsion from a Florida school and the reason for the expulsion indicates the student is a danger to himself/herself or others. All alternative school placements must be approved by the Superintendent of Schools and/or his/her designee.

Post Commitment Probation

The district requires students on post commitment probation to attend an alternative school placement before being allowed to return to a traditional school setting. However, their placement at an alternative school is not guaranteed if the student has not completed a recent expulsion from a Florida school and the reason for the expulsion indicates the student is a danger to himself/herself or others. All alternative school placements must be approved by the Superintendent of Schools and/or his/her designee.

In short, students returning from incarceration are required to attend an alternative school before enrolling in a traditional school setting for a period of at least one semester. During their enrollment at the alternative school, an assessment is made to determine if the student can successfully transition to the traditional setting and thrive.
